






Report:

On 29th October,2022 we visited the Kesrolli Village, located in Haliyal taluk of Uttara Kannada District, Karnataka-602809. It is situated 5km away from sub-district headquarter Haliyal (tehsildar office) and 140km away from district headquarter Karwar. The population is around 2000 and there are around 70 families residing in the village.

We had been to the gram panchayat headed by Mr. Ganapati Patil, and had a talk on a few important matters regarding the village and the problems faced by the villagers with respect to the facilities and lifestyle.

Here are few things we had a discussion on:

EDUCATION:

A primary school takes care of the education of the children in the village. For higher education people have to travel to the nearby town, Haliyal. Under the Sarva Shiksha Abhiyan, computers have been provided to the school in the village. Anganwadis, in the village take care of the pre school education for the kids between the age of 3 to 6 years. Every child in the village is being educated.

HEALTH:

There is an ANM subcentre in the village. Health awareness is being provided and surveys are done for communicable diseases like TB, Leprosy, Malaria etc and non-communicable diseases like diabetes, hypertension etc. Emergency medical shops are not available and people have to go to the Taluka Hospital, Haliyal for major ailments. They have an ambulance service for the village that takes around 20 minutes to reach the hospitals. Universal immunization program is being carried out regularly in the subcentre. Almost 80% villagers are vaccinated against COVID-19.

WATER AND ELECTRICITY:

Water supply for the village is by an overhead tank, for 4-5 hours once in 2 days and a tax of Rs.400(without tap) and Rs.600(with tap) is collected from the villagers.

Jal Jeevan mission that is envisioned to provide safe and adequate drinking water is also launched in the village. Karnataka power transmission corporation limited (KPTCL) is responsible for the provision of electricity to the village, street lights are made available to the villagers.

OTHER FACILITIES:

There is no ATM and bank facility in the village, villagers have to go to the nearby town, but every person in village has a bank account. Jana Dhana yojana has been carried out in the village. Women safety has been taken care in the village. Voting percentage in the village is 60-80 %, There are 5 wards and 5 booths. Beat police comes once in a week. The main income comes from agriculture, such as Mango, Sapota, beetle nut. Action plan has been made and agriculture land has been made available. Waste disposal has been taken care.

OUTCOMES OF THE VILLAGE VISIT:

- This survey enabled us in studying the various aspects of the village life
- > This visit helped us understand the lives of villagers, their needs and various dynamics relating to it.
- We also saw the various development plans running in the village and the impact of it helped us sharpen our understanding of these plans and ground realities associated with them.
- > There is sufficient scope of improvements in he village related to the providing of livelihood opportunities to the villagers
