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Report on Industry Visit to Grasim Industries, Chemical Division, Karwar.

The 3rd Semester students of **Computer Science and Engineering (CSE)**, undertook an **industrial exposure visit under the Bureau of Indian Standards (BIS)** initiative. The visit was organized to **Grasim Industries, Chemical Division, Karwar on 18-12-2025**, with the objective of familiarizing students with industrial standards, quality assurance mechanisms, safety practices, and real-world industrial operations.

Objectives of the Visit

The primary objectives of the exposure visit were:
