His talk, titled **“Conquer the Career: The Roadmap for a 4-Year Engineering Course”** was a strategic blueprint for students to navigate their academic journey with clarity, purpose, and passion. - **Growth Mind-set:** Mr. Gudi urged Students to Embrace Challenges, Learn from Setbacks, and stay committed to continuous improvement.





: Brief Report on Day – 4 : (11th September 2025)

Events: Bridge Course, Digvijay Diwas Celebration, Career Preparedness Session

The Fourth Day of SIP-2025 began with a Bridge Course designed to strengthen foundational concepts and ease the Academic transition for First-Year Students. This was followed by a deeply inspiring celebration of Digvijay Diwas, commemorating the return of Swami Vivekananda to India on September 11, 1893, after his historic address at the Vishwa Dharma Sammelana (World Parliament of Religions) in Chicago.

Session 1: Digvijay Diwas Celebration (11:15 AM – 12:15 PM)

The event was graced by Shri. Satyanarayana Bhat, Retired Chief Manager, State Bank of India, Sirsi, who served as the Chief Guest. He spoke passionately about Swami Vivekananda's contributions to Indian Thought, Youth Empowerment, and Spiritual Nationalism. Swami Vivekananda believed that to be a Truly Impactful Engineer, one must imbibe qualities such as:

- **Nationalism rooted in Service**, not Ego
- **Spiritual Integrity**, where Ethics and purpose Guide Innovation
- **Selfless Dedication** to Societal upliftment

- Building a **Positive Attitude**, Resilience and Adaptability

- Punctuality, Discipline, and Proactive Communication with Faculty

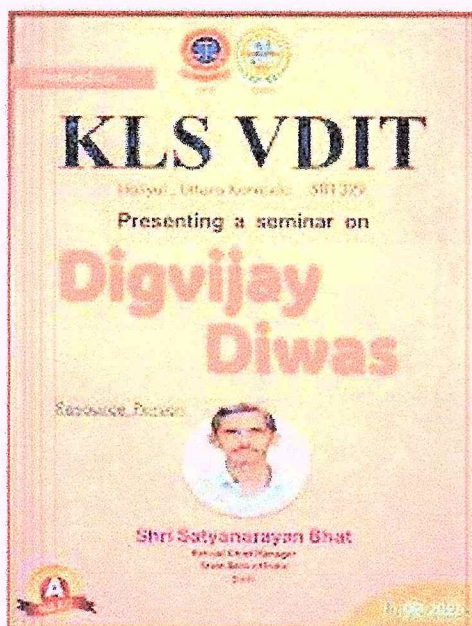
The session emphasized that academic success is not just about Intelligence—it's about **Consistency, Accountability, and Professional Behaviour**.

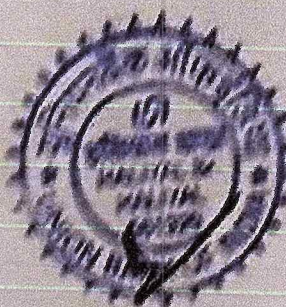
